Write an email asking John to join the dance competition with you.

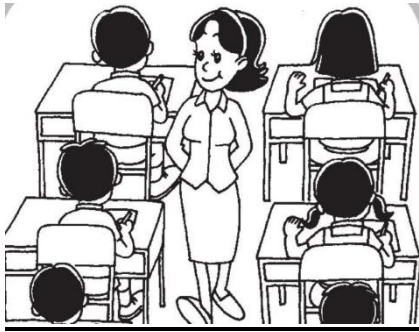
In your writing, include the following key information:
